**Minutes from January reviewed.** Doug motioned to approve January Minutes. Todd seconded. All were in favor.

Dianna Repp: Activities Director spoke to us about Special Olympics Basketball Team

- Grayslake High School District Special Olympics Basketball Team will participate at State on Friday March 13th. This is the 3rd year students have gone to State and she would like us to pay for half of a fan bus to transport students to cheer on their peers. Both Central & North students participate.

- Ross Gantt Meet is April 18th. Asking for the Boosters to provide the same donations as last year

**Coaches' Requests**

- Kelsey Pierotti - Cheerleading
  - Boosters to reimburse SAF account \$440 for shirts celebrating making it to State (22 athletes @ \$20/shirt)
- Jimmy Centella - Cross Country
  - Boosters to reimburse SAF account \$120 for shirts celebrating making it to State (6 athletes @ \$20/shirt)
- Special Olympics: pay for half a fan bus for Central Students to travel to Illinois Wesleyan to watch Grayslake High School District Special Olympics Basketball Team participate at State on Friday March 13th.
  - Tony motioned to approve Dianna Repp's fan bus request. Todd seconded. All were in favor.
- Jason Schall - Softball
  - Boosters to deposit \$900.00 into SAF account for meal money for Spring Break trip: 12 athletes for 5 days at \$15/day
  - Jo motioned to approve Softball Spring Break meal money request. Jay seconded. All were in favor.
- Troy Whalen - Baseball
  - Boosters to deposit \$2025.00 into SAF account for meal money for Spring Break trip: 27 athletes for 5 days at \$15/day = \$2,025.00
    - Original request was for 7 days: Bylaws cap number of days at 5 - amount adjusted
  - Jo motioned to approve Baseball Spring Break meal money request. Melissa seconded. All were in favor.
    - Caveat to approval: share with coaches our concern that their sport has low volunteer numbers and we are looking for a higher turnout
- Chris Ridella - Lacrosse
  - Boosters to deposit \$2025.00 into SAF account for meal money for Spring Break trip: 27 athletes for 5 days at \$15/day = \$2,025.00
  - Jeff motioned to approve Lacrosse Spring Break meal money request. Todd seconded. All were in favor.

- Jason Schall - Softball

- Spiritwear sales to date (2019-2020) \$18,600
- All stadium seats sold - will wait until late summer to order more
